## Cristina Sorribas and Anuradha Pal

Dr. Anuradha Pal is from India, with education background, working in the social sector with Humana People to People India (HPPI) since 2013 and currently being the Team Leader in one of their Teaching Trainings Institutions.



Cristina Sorribas is from Spain, with psychology in education and social work background, she has been engaged in the social sector since she was pursuing her degree. She joined HPPI in 2015 and since then has been Education Programme Manager and development & International Training Leader, coordinating the education projects at National level.

Their presentation will provide to the students an overview of the education in India and how it provides a balance, equity and development to the society through literacy.

He is the co-founder and director of the independent TFF – The Transnational Foundation for Peace & Future Research in Lund, Sweden, since 1985. Jan Øberg has contributed to many of our Peace Justice Conferences and always brings a valuable perspective on the reasoning behind many of the global conflicts, how we can promote Peace and the global attitudes towards Peace that he has experienced in his many decades of work.



## Lyla June

**Saturday 18th 16.30-18.00**



Dr. Lyla June Johnston (aka Lyla June) is an Indigenous musician, author, and community organizer of Diné (Navajo), Tsétsêhéstâhese (Cheyenne) and European lineages. Her multi-genre presentation style has engaged audiences across the globe towards personal, collective, and ecological healing. She blends her study of Human Ecology at Stanford, graduate work in Indigenous Pedagogy, and the traditional worldview she grew up with to inform her music, perspectives and solutions. She will be discussing how teachers can empower their students to understand, reckon with, and begin to transform our violent colonial past.

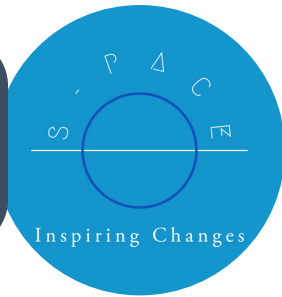
## Andrés Barrientos
